<b>Bloodroot*</b>	<i>Sanguinaria canadensis</i>	10-12
<b>Jack-in-the-pulpit*</b>	<i>Ariseaema triphyllum</i>	5-7
<b>Virginia Bluebells</b>	<i>Mertensia virginica</i>	3-5
<b>Lily of the Valley</b>	<i>Convallaria majalis</i>	5-7
<b>Creeping Wintergreen</b>	<i>Gaultheria procumbens</i>	2
<b>Italian Arum</b>	<i>Arum Italicum 'Marmoratum'</i>	5-7
<b>Rocket Ligularia</b> (Little Rocket Ligularia would be best)	<i>Ligularia stenocephala</i>	1
<b>Russian Sage</b>	<i>Perovskia atriplicifolia</i>	1
<b>Large Yellow Lady Slipper*</b>	<i>Cypripedium, Parviflorum var. pubescens</i>	1 (a native orchid, coveted by gardeners)
<b>Alumroot / Coral Bells</b>	<i>Heuchera</i> (any variety)	3-4
<b>Lavender</b>		1
<b>Verbascum (Southern Charm)</b>	Any variety/shade	2-3
<b>Spiderwort / Widow's Tears</b>	<i>Tradescantia</i> (any shade)	2-3
<b>Foam Flower</b>	<i>Tiarella</i> (any variety)	2-3
<b>Toad Lily "Blue Wonder"</b>	<i>Tricyrtis "Blue Wonder"</i>	1
<b>Creeping Phlox</b>	<i>Phlox subulata</i> (any shade)	2-3
